INTRODUCTION

Ubique Risk Management partnered with the National Skills Academy for Nuclear (NSAN) to create and deliver the all-new 'Triple Bar Nuclear Security' (TBNS) training course.

OBJECTIVE

The course was developed to provide learners with first-hand practical knowledge of working securely within the civil nuclear industry in the United Kingdom. The content covers a range of aspects intended to educate and encourage positive engagement in their organisation's and client's security cultures. It also highlights common areas of risk and provides guidance on avoiding pitfalls, and protecting individuals, their organisations, and the civil nuclear industry as a whole.

The TBNS is designed to be of use to persons in any job role, providing them with a distinct advantage in a highly regulated environment.

SOLUTION

The course aims to increase the knowledge and understanding of learners about the fundamentals of nuclear security in the UK focussing on core concepts including:
